The packaging described herein has been assessed in accordance with Annex VII (Module A — Internal Production Control) of Regulation (EU) 2025/40. The manufacturer declares that the packaging meets the applicable requirements of Articles 5 through 12 as follows: substance concentration limits under Article 5 are supported by supplier Heavy-Metal and PFAS declarations held in the technical file for all suppliers that provide them (Burgess Manufacturing, Supply One, SupplyOne, supply one); remaining suppliers are marked Not required by the site; packaging weight and volume have been minimised under Article 10; the packaging is a mix of fibre, wood and a minor plastic fraction (banding, sheeting), so Article 7 recycled-content minimums apply to the plastic fraction from 2030 (0% conservatively assumed pending supplier data); Article 6 grades phase in from 2030; labelling under Article 12 applies from 12 August 2028. This packaging is single-use, one-way, and is not placed on the market as reusable, so Article 11 reuse-system requirements do not apply. Covers the OKC BoxLWP/BoxLWPWF/Consolidated; component weights (kg) are in the PTD sheet.
