The packaging described herein has been assessed in accordance with Annex VII (Module A — Internal Production Control) of Regulation (EU) 2025/40. The manufacturer declares that the packaging meets the applicable requirements of Articles 5 through 12 as follows: substance concentration limits under Article 5 are addressed via supplier heavy-metal declarations held in the technical file — heavy-metal declarations are ON FILE for every supplied component; shipping labels, packing slips, and the branded packing pouch are Maxcess-generated internal items requiring no supplier declaration. PFAS Article 5 limits apply to food-contact packaging only and are not in scope for this non-food-contact family. Packaging weight and volume have been minimised under Article 10; reusability requirements under Article 11 are not applicable (single-use, one-way); recyclability grades under Article 6 and recycled-content minimums under Article 7 (plastic) phase in from 2030; labelling under Article 12 applies from 12 August 2028. Solid-wood crates are ISPM-15 heat-treated and stamped (phytosanitary marking confirmed). Covers Webex wooden transport crates (S/M/L); component weights (kg) are in the PTD sheet.
